## **ACRYLIC WORKSHOPS**

Setup & Cleanup Time: 30 min. Each

### **About the Art Instructor**

Taylor Rae Cole (they/them) is a Philly based, mixed media artist specializing in abstract acrylics and illustrative watercolors. They earned their BA in Fine Arts from Albright College and have over 15 years experience working with both watercolor and acrylic paints. They began offering art workshops in 2019.

#### **Workshop Details**

I will provide all the necessary tools and materials for the workshops (brushes, canvases, cups, paints, pallets, paper towels, hairdryers to expedite drying time etc). If you'd like to protect your tables or floors from paint, I recommend tablecloths and/or drop cloths be used at the host's discretion. Acrylic paint can be cleaned off most non-porous services, but it does bind rather quickly to fabrics. For this reason, I encourage participants to wear clothes they aren't afraid to get messy!

My workshops place heavy emphasis on the creative process. We do not strive to create exact replicas of finished paintings. Instead, we focus on a specific technique or theme to explore. I always bring along at least two variations on the theme for whichever workshop I'm teaching & encourage participants to make their own choices as we craft our compositions. I find that having contrasting examples helps participants visualize a wider range of possibilities for their own work. No two paintings will ever be the same. Participants will leave my workshops with their own one-of-a-kind artwork, having learned a few painting techniques along the way.

If you are interested in hosting one of my workshops, you will need to provide the following:

- A well-lit location with enough room for everyone to paint comfortably
  - Note: Tables or desks should be arranged so all participants have a clear line-of-sight to watch the instructor. If you would like guidance on how best to do this, please reach out and I will happily assist you!
- A functional sink to be used before/during/after the workshop (filling water cups, washing paint brushes, etc.)
- Access to an electrical outlet (for our "drying station" hairdryers)

# **Changes to Reservation / Cancellations**

Did you overestimate or underestimate your headcount? Group sizes can be changed up to two weeks (14 days) prior to the event date. The group size (and corresponding event price) will be locked-in two weeks prior to the event and cannot be adjusted after that point. This is to ensure I have the necessary amount of time to prep tools and materials for your event. Similarly, requests to reschedule the date of an event can only be accommodated up to two weeks prior to the original event date.

If you must cancel your scheduled paint event for any reason, please do so no later than one week (7 days) prior to the event date. Late notice cancellations (less than 7 days) will result in a cancellation fee of \$100. Why this fee? By the week of an event, I have already invested time and materials into prepping the workshop. As a self-employed independent artist, I can't afford to absorb such losses. This policy is in place to discourage last-minute cancellations and to ensure I recoup some portion of loss when they do occur. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding!
